

SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION AND NOTICE

Under and by virtue of Title 11 Oklahoma Statutes, Section 16-101, and City of Catoosa Ordinance No. 2023-439-C dated this 22nd day of May, 2023, authorizing the calling of an election on the proposition stated in this proclamation and notice, I, the undersigned Mayor of the City of Catoosa, Oklahoma (the “City”), call and give notice of a special election to be held in the City on August 8, 2023, to submit the following proposition to the registered, qualified voters in the City.

PROPOSITION II

Shall Ordinance No. 2023-439-C of the City Council of the City of Catoosa, Oklahoma, increasing the excise tax upon the gross proceeds or gross receipts derived from all rent received for every occupancy of a room or rooms in a hotel-motel by three percent (3%) to a total of eight percent (8%) effective January 1, 2024, be approved?

Shall the proposed ordinance be approved?

FOR THE PROPOSITION - YES

AGAINST THE PROPOSITION – NO

Only registered, qualified voters of the City of Catoosa may vote upon the above proposition.

The polls shall be opened at 7:00 o’clock a.m. and remain open continuously until 7:00 o’clock p.m.

That the number and location of the polling places for said election shall be the same as the regular precinct polling places designated for statewide and local elections by the Rogers County Election Board. The persons who shall conduct the election shall be those precinct officers designated by the Rogers County Election Board, which officers shall also act as counters and certify the election results as required by law.

The approval of the proposition shall require a simple 50% plus one vote majority.
